Each entry costs £1, payable in cash when submitting your entry.

Judging will take place between **10.30am and 12pm** on **Sunday 6th September**. **The judges’ decision is final.**

Cups will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each class.

All entries must remain on display until 7pm on Sunday 6th September and be removed by 8pm, otherwise they will be disposed of.
